Out with the old, in with the new: The former "Black Box" Cone Health building on Northwood Street (Piedmont AHEC's old location) was demolished in February to make space for the expansion.

Cone Health Expansion Underway

Work is underway on the new expansion of Cone Health Heart & Vascular Center. Stretching into the space along Northwood Street in Greensboro, where Piedmont AHEC's former building was located, the project will create and renovate more than 260,000 square feet of space for the purpose of disease prevention, cardiovascular care, and community wellness.

Included in the total square footage will be a 156,000-square-foot, five-story outpatient tower on the campus of Moses H. Cone Memorial Hospital, plus 37,000 square feet of new and renovated space inside the hospital, and a 775-space parking deck for heart and vascular patients.

In addition, Alamance Regional Medical Center will soon see an additional 63,000 square feet of new and renovated heart and vascular care space.

The expanded space, broadened focus, and addition of new technologies at both campuses hold great promise for future precepting opportunities, and Piedmont AHEC will be eagerly watching the development of these projects and looking for opportunities for both preceptors and students.
