Piedmont AHEC Launches Workforce Initiative



Talent Pipeline Management

Healthcare employers are experiencing record talent shortages. In an effort to reverse the trend, NC AHEC has partnered with the NC Center on the Workforce for Health and the NC Chamber Foundation to implement a plan aimed at creating a strong and sustainable generation of healthcare professionals.

Piedmont AHEC is one of four AHECs participating in the NC Health Talent Alliance and will use a proven approach called Talent Pipeline Management (TPM) to identify and quantify critical workforce needs for the future. The TPM method builds an employer collaborative that will cocreate data-driven solutions with education partners and build effective and sustainable talent pipelines. The Piedmont AHEC will formally launch the employer collaborative in January of 2024.

Making Care Primary Model

CMS have rolled out a Making Care Primary (MCP) model that could benefit your practice. This is a 10-year program to support and delivery of advanced FQHCs and other small independent practices. Making Care Primary (MCP) is a 10.5-year value-based care (VBC) model operated by the CMS Innovation Center (CMMI). CMMI will work with Making Care Primary participants to drive advanced, coordinated, high quality care for patients in their communities. Below is a playbook that outlines this model, and the purpose is to provide an overview of key model design elements for potential model applicants.
