

GREENSBORO AHEC SCHOLARS PROGRAM IS NOW ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR 2020 - 2022

Do you want to be a part of a community of lifelong learners, responsible global citizens, and a network of interprofessionals whom are dedicated to improving health care? Are you wondering how to set yourself apart in an ever changing and increasingly competitive health care system?

If you find yourself asking these questions, then the AHEC Scholars Program is for <u>you</u>. Scholars will develop new skills and are introduced to an interprofessional framework that will be crucial to improving health and health care. We teach, model, and encourage a love of learning, collaboration, and compassion for others. Working collaboratively to ensure every student achieves academically, socially, and emotionally.

WIIFM-What's in it for me?

The two-year NC AHEC Scholars Program includes 40 hours of didactics and 40 hours of clinical work each year. Selected applicants to participate in the program will receive a stipend subject to academic or institutional approval. Upon completion of the program, NC AHEC Scholars receive AHEC Community Health Scholar certification, setting them apart from other students in an increasingly competitive environment.

You will cultivate a number of professional skills including but not limited to:

- Problem solving, decision making, resourcefulness, working on a team, self-discipline, and commitment.
- Your certification as an AHEC Community Health Scholar will announce to the world that you have the knowledge, skills and attitude necessary to make a difference in healthcare.
- As an NC AHEC Scholar, you'll have access to a vast network, statewide NC AHEC
 resources, and more—including the AHEC Digital Library, which you'll find useful
 throughout your career in health care.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Interested applicants for the 2020-22 NC AHEC Scholars Program must complete the application by **June 30th**. Applicants will be notified on **July 31st, 2020.** To apply, download and fill out the application form, save it to your computer, and email it to Patricia.Parrish@conehealth.com. **Click here for the 2020-22 AHEC Scholars Program application form.** Please note that you will need to download the PDF to your computer and then open it to be able to utilize the fill-in PDF features.

Qualified and eligible applicants will move into the review phase of the application process. Each region's Application Review Committee will review the applications and select finalists for in-person and/or phone interviews. The final selection of 2020-22 NC AHEC Scholars will be notified by July 31st. A new cohort of students will be added each year. The program will begin in September and run through May each year, beginning in 2020-22.

Additional application and onboarding materials may be required. Applicants will be notified of requirements.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

The NC AHEC Scholars Program aims to meet multiple, identified gaps in the North Carolina health care workforce. Please See attached list of all accepted programs to participate in the Scholars program. In order to be eligible for the Scholars program you must already be enrolled in one of these programs listed. Scholars must have reliable access to internet connection, transportation, and must be eligible to work in the US. Each scholar will commit to the program for a total of 2 years. Applications from health professions students from disadvantaged and/or rural backgrounds, underrepresented minorities, and first-generation college will be heavily weighted. Each of the nine NC AHEC regions will select a group of scholars that represent diverse backgrounds and institutions and a variety of health care professions, including dentistry, management science, medicine, nursing, occupational therapy, physical therapy, psychology, social work, speech therapy, and many others. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Interested applicants must fill out and submit the application form:

- Answer one 500-word essay question
- Two general Letters of Recommendation. Please have your recommender's send their recommendation via email directly to Patricia Parrish.
- Resume
- Official Transcript
