Effective August 25, 2023, AHEC Housing does not have a COVID-19 vaccination policy beyond what schools or clinical sites require. It is assumed that you are in compliance with your program's vaccination policies. This may mean that students from different programs are vaccinated to different extents. Please be aware of this if you choose to use AHEC housing.

If you have symptoms of the COVID-19 virus, have a known COVID-19 exposure, or test positive for COVID-19, please follow these guidelines:

- If you have [symptoms](#), notify your school's student health office immediately and follow their guidelines. If you need to cancel your housing request, notify the regional AHEC as soon as possible (you/your school will not be charged for a COVID-19 related cancellation).
- If you were exposed to COVID-19, please follow the [recommended precautions](#), including recommendations for post-exposure testing.
- If you test positive for COVID-19, you must leave AHEC housing as soon as possible. You may not return to AHEC housing until your isolation period ends (see [current CDC guidelines](#) to determine proper isolation period timeframe). If you need to cancel your housing, notify the regional AHEC as soon as possible (you/your school will not be charged for a COVID-19 related cancellation).
