

List of Accepted Programs for the NC AHEC Scholars Program

Discipline Eligibility: Students are eligible when they are formally admitted into a credential-bearing health professions program that leads to licensure, certification, or a recognized healthcare workforce role aligned with HRSA priorities. With the exception of CHWs, students must have 2 years left in their training program coinciding with graduating from their health professions program and the AHEC Scholars program.
